Innovation and Incubation Centres are powerful economic development tools to boost the entrepreneurial culture in any country. They promote the concept of growth through innovation and application of technology, support economic development strategies for small Business development, and encourage growth from within local economies, while also providing a mechanism for technology transfer.

Making its beginning in 2016, MIIC focused its efforts to provide business support processes that accelerate the growth of incubated startups by providing the entrepreneurs with varied resources and services. These services were orchestrated by MIIC management and were offered both through MIIC incubators and its network of contracts.

Such focused efforts attracted a lot many number of startups to MIIC, which were thoroughly screened by the recommendation committee on innovation and scalability criteria before allowing incubation. A total number of seventeen bright and innovative startups were incubated at MIIC during the period of 2017-2018.

To generate awareness and provide the incubatees with a kick start various kinds of programs like Panel Discussions, Focus Group Discussion with industry experts and mentors, Science Conclave and Awareness talks were conducted. Workshops on various startup related issues like IPR policies/grants/schemes for startups and stakeholder consultation meetings on Science technology and innovation were also organized. MIIC also conducted a seven days "Corporate Executive Training" Programme for engineers and managers of REIL, Jaipur. Besides this MIIC signed an MOU the CG Global Corp to join hands and work towards, the cause of developing first generation enterprises in the areas of Agro and Food Processing.

The new MIIC building in the making strengthen our commitment to provide Management Guidance, Technical Assistance and Consulting Tailored for young incubated startups.

With these as basis, the DST funds were efficiently and effectively utilized throughout the year for various designated purposes.

I present the annual report 2017- 2018 that signifies our commitment for establishing a robust startup growth supporting system for stable hand holding of the incubated startups which would ultimately strengthen local and National economies.
